Fundamentals

Wrender considers privacy and protection of your data is of great importance. Any information you supply to us is used only to contact you as needed for providing you with a service or product that you have agreed upon.

We do not sell your data to any third party.

This page explains our privacy policy and how we use and protect any information about you that you give us.

Data security

We take organisational, contractual and technical safety precautions to be sure of compliance with formalities of the data protection laws as well as protection of the data used by us against accidental or deliberate manipulation, loss, destruction or unauthorised access.

The safety measures notably include the encrypted transmission of all data between your browser and our server, where a browser is the means by which the data has been sent to us.

Data disclosure

PII will only be transferred to third parties if it is necessary if required for contractual purposes or on the basis of legitimate interests of economic and efficient operations for your service or product provided by us.

When passing data third parties to provide our services or products, we take legal precautions as well as technical and organisational measurements to ensure the safety of personal data in accordance with the data protection law.

Data retention

PII that we process for any purpose or purposes shall not be kept for longer than is necessary for that purpose or those purposes.

Request for information and Right to be forgotten

To request PII that we store related to you, amendments to your PII, or if you'd like all of your data to be erased then please contact our Data Protection Officer specified at the bottom of this policy and we will endeavour to implement your request within 30 days or request an extension if this is not reasonably possible within this time limit.

We do not pass on any of your personal information when dealing with your enquiry, unless you have given us permission to do so.

Cookie policy

Cookies are pieces of data that are often created when you visit a website, and contain an identifier (a string of letters and numbers).

Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies: a persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date, unless deleted by the user before the expiry date; a session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed.

Cookies do not typically contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal information that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.
